This Privacy Policy explains how Mrs. Rosie's Home Childcare Service ("we", "us", or "our") collects, uses, and shares information when you visit <https://littlerosebudchildcare.com> (the "Site").

Information We Collect

1) Comments

When visitors leave comments on the Site, we collect the data shown in the comments form, as well as the visitor's IP address and browser user agent string to help with spam detection.

An anonymized string created from your email address (also called a hash) may be provided to the Gravatar service to see if you are using it. After approval of your comment, your profile picture may be visible to the public in the context of your comment.

2) Media Uploads

If you upload images to the Site, you should avoid uploading images with embedded location data (EXIF GPS). Visitors to the Site can download and extract any location data from images on the Site.

3) Cookies

We use cookies to support Site functionality and improve your experience. Cookies may be set in the following situations:

- If you leave a comment, you may opt-in to saving your name, email address, and website in cookies for your convenience. These cookies last for one year.
- If you have an account and log in, we set a temporary cookie to determine if your browser accepts cookies. This cookie contains no personal data and is discarded when you close your browser.
- When you log in, we set cookies to save your login information and screen display choices. Login cookies last for two days; screen options cookies last for a year. If you select "Remember Me", your login may persist for two weeks.
- If you edit or publish an article, an additional cookie may be saved in your browser that indicates the post ID of the article you just edited. It expires after 1 day.

Cookie Preferences

The Site provides cookie preference controls. Depending on your choices, some types of cookies or third-party features (such as maps, videos, or web fonts) may be blocked and the Site's functionality and appearance may be reduced.

4) Embedded Content from Other Websites

Articles on this Site may include embedded content (e.g., videos, images, articles). Embedded content from other websites behaves in the same way as if the visitor has visited the other website. These websites may collect data about you, use cookies, embed additional third-party tracking, and monitor your interaction with embedded content, including tracking your interaction if you have an account and are logged in to that website.

How We Use Your Information

We use information we collect to:

- Operate and maintain the Site.
- Respond to inquiries and provide customer support.
- Facilitate comments and help detect or prevent spam.
- Improve the Site's content and user experience.

Who We Share Your Data With

Visitor comments may be checked through an automated spam detection service. We may also share information with service providers that help us operate the Site (for example, hosting providers and embedded content providers) as needed to provide the Site and its features.

How Long We Retain Your Data

If you leave a comment, the comment and its metadata may be retained indefinitely so we can recognize and approve follow-up comments automatically rather than holding them in a moderation queue.

For users that register on our website (if any), we also store the personal information they provide in their user profile. Users can see, edit, or delete their personal information at any time (except they cannot change their username). Website administrators can also see and edit that information.

Your Rights

If you have an account on this Site, or have left comments, you can request to receive an exported file of the personal data we hold about you, including any data you have provided to us. You can also request that we erase personal data we hold about you. This does not include any data we are obliged to keep for administrative, legal, or security purposes.
